Dear ambassador Mikael Hemniti Winther:

I have the great honor to write this letter informing you about my great concern of the arrest of our members in Thailand.

I am the president of Khmer National Liberation Front which have established officially in Denmark on 12th December 2012. I would like to pay my deep appreciation to you that gave us chance to meet you at the embassy on 22nd August 2012.

I am very concerned about the arrest of our members in Thailand on 8th March 2013 and on 14th March 2013. This is a serious situation which Cambodian government violated the human rights and freedom not only in Cambodia but they do also outside; furthermore, they violated the United Nations convention in 1951 and the International Law relating to status of refugee and asylum seekers.

Cambodian authorities cooperated with Thai authorities arrested our members from Wat Deng pracharat pagoda, Nonthaburi province. There are three monks and two men. Two monks whose names are Venerable Thach Cung Phoung and Venerable Yan Kimsrun were meeting with you on 22nd August 2012. Another monk is Venerable Yean Yoeub and two men Mr. Khemara and Mr. Danh Dai. They are seeking the political asylum with the office of United Nations High Commissioner for Refugee in Thailand.

Therefore, I would like to appeal to you to bring these issues to the International Communities and the United Nations to put a pressure against Cambodian government and Vietnam to release them a favor.
